## 研究成果の概要

Regional cooperation is one of the important aspects of contemporary international relations and has vast potential for accelerating economic growth, reducing poverty and economic disparity within and across the countries involved, and addressing the challenges of managing scarce resources. The absence of political, economic and institutional coordination can cause conflicts and contentions even in the states with historical and cultural linkages. Central Asian region is no exception to such situations. Cumulative policy measures are imperative to foster cooperation among Central Asian states through cross-border trade and to support key institutions that can strengthen such trade. Inception of organization such as Eurasian Economic Union, Custom Union, and Eurasian Economic Community have acted as the motivation force for the member states which are expecting faster economic development of the region. Formation of these organizations have facilitated to a certain degree open movement of goods, free flow of capital, service and labour, availability of market for consumers as well as availability of common market without tariff or non-tariff barriers with unified legislation. The positive impact of integration process is that, it has brought Central Asian states into a cooperative framework which has stabilized the region to a greater extent, hereby reducing the interstate tension and providing resolution on belligerent subjects.

During my stay at Slavic Eurasian Research Center (SRC), Hokkaido University (from 8<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> October in 2021 and from 21<sup>st</sup>-25<sup>th</sup> March in 2022) I reviewed books and documents, conducted research and collected material from SRC library and Hokkaido University library.
