Professor Byram is the Director of Research Degrees dealing with topics such as **'intercultural studies in education**', **'bilingual education**' and **'policy studies in education**'. He is a Programme Adviser to *the Council of Europe Language Policy Division*, and is currently interested in **language education policy** and **the politics of language teaching**. He has published several books including, most recently, *Teaching and Assessing Intercultural Communicative Competence (1994); Language Teachers, Politics and Cultures (with Karen Risager, 1999); Inter-*



cultural Experience and Education (edited with G. Alred and M. Fleming, 2002). He is the editor of the *Routledge Encyclopedia of Language Teaching and Learning* (2000), and joint Series Editor of *'Languages for Intercultural Communication and Education'*.
