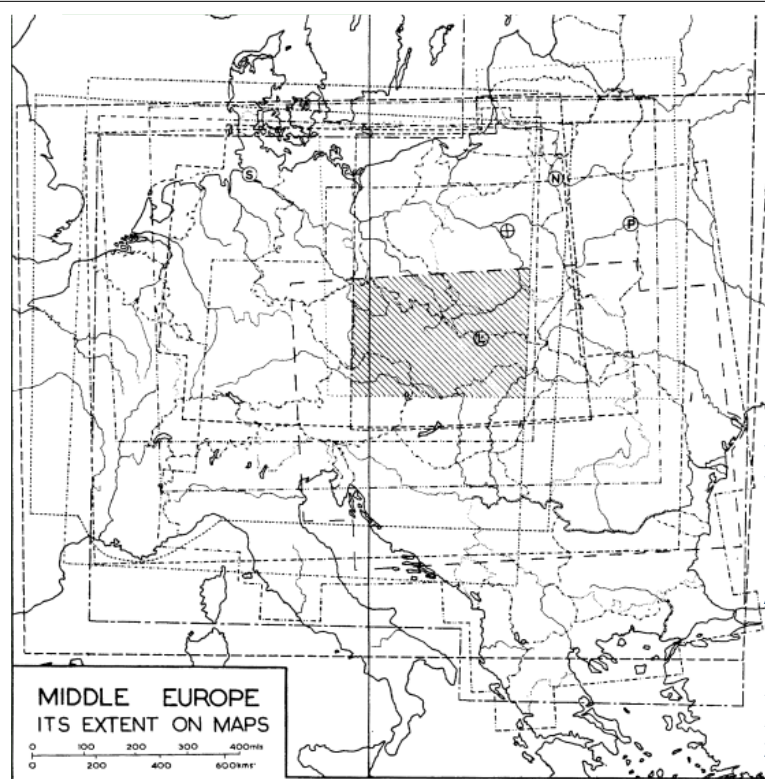


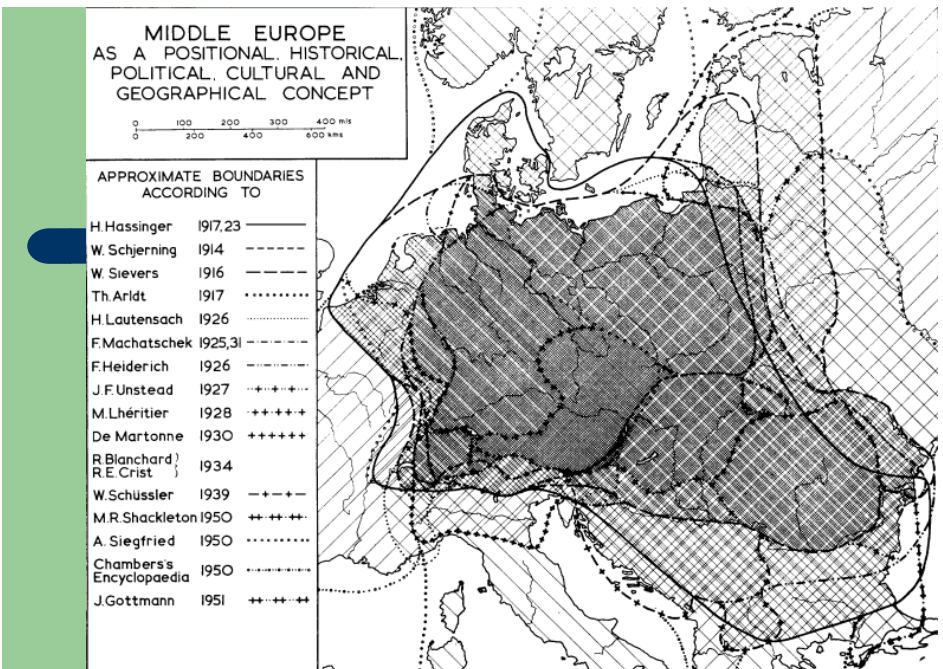


Central Europe, 1910.

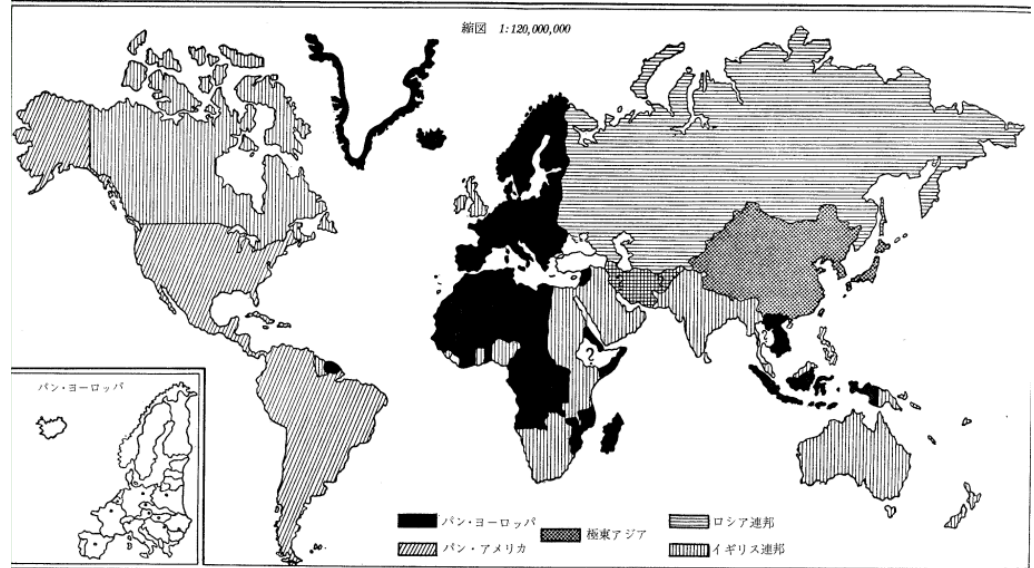
